Asbury Park, New Jersey – June 15, 2009 - Billy Lilley, Asbury Park resident, Vietnam Veteran, Eagle Scout and well known harmonica player has liver cancer. He is currently on the liver donor transplant list and is anticipated that the transplant will be within six months.

The 57 year old and his wife, Theresa of 35 years are residents of Asbury Park for 23 years. They are founding members of the Jersey Shore Jazz Blues Foundation and have dedicated many years to tirelessly working to build a better community through non-profits at the shore such as: Jersey Shore Jazz & Blues Foundation, Clear Water and ABATE (ABATE of the Garden State is a non-partisan legislative organization that represents the interests of the over 165,000 registered motorcyclists in New Jersey.) They were an integral part of the team that organized the motorcycle run in the late 1980's that raised \$10,000 for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in the PNC Bank Arts Center and \$5,000 for ABATE.

Lilley is well known in the music world on the Jersey Shore. He has played with the Tri-Plex Blues Band, Renegade Blues Band and the Fairlanes with Billy Hector.

"We send out our best wishes to Billy for a speedy recovery and to Theresa for founding The Jersey Shore Jazz Blues Foundation and their past support. Billy is a talented musician and has always been there to help support others in need and our educational programs through the foundation. He truly understands the meaning of "Friend".
